

Emmanuel South Oakleigh Cricket Club - Coach Training Policy

1. The Club values its Coaches to the point that it will fund the Training of the Coach to that of a Level 1- Cricket Coach. The expectation of the Coach is then for at least 2(two) Seasons of Service in the capacity of a Junior Grade Coach. Coach Training is provided by Cricket Victoria and involves an on-line "fill in the gaps" course and a one-day practical session, including a (non-threatening) practical examination. Training course information available from www.cricketvictoria.com.au. - **Applications to be made through the Club Secretary.**
2. From 1st January, 2008, Junior Grade Coaches will be required to have a **Working With Children check** performed**. As a Volunteer Coach there is NO FEE for this check, but the Club has engaged to ensure the Coach has a current WWC check. - **Applications to be made through the Club Secretary.**

Note: The rationale behind the **WWC** requirement is that E.S.O.C.C is a "club, association or movement (recreational and sporting) that provides services or activities for children or whose membership mainly comprises children".

Exemptions from the WWC – There are now **NO exemptions from the WWC Check
