## Emmanuel South Oakleigh Cricket Club – Game Day Player Expectations Policy

These are targeted at the Senior Players, but can be extended to the Junior ranks also. With ALL Club Members knowing what is expected of them, there can be no reason for ignorance.

- 1. **DAILY:** ALL Players are requested to be at the Club at least 1¼ hour before the start of the Day's play.
- 2. **DAILY: (HOME SIDE)** Should covers be in use on the wicket at Scammell Reserve, you will be expected to assist in their placement and removal. In the Mercantile Cricket Competition there is an expectation that a visiting Side will also render assistance at Away Games, but during the game. (For covers instructions for Sunday, Call the MCA Wet Weather Line: 1900939238 Option "0" on the Saturday after 10am)
- 3. **DAILY: (HOME SIDE)** Creases need to be swept and marked with spray-paint. Take Stumps and bails from the Training Room for the Umpire.
- 4. **DAILY: (HOME SIDE)** Preparation of Drinks/Cordial and Cups for the Drinks Breaks.
- 5. **DAILY: (HOME SIDE)** Hang up the Electronic Scoreboard on the Clubroom external wall. Brackets are already in place.
- 6. **DAILY: (HOME SIDE)** Assistance with the serving of Afternoon Tea. Tables to and from the Rooms and food from the Canteen fridge.
- 7. **DAILY: (HOME SIDE)** Assistance with the collection of Players' Daily subs.
- 8. **DAILY: (HOME SIDE)** Assistance with the cleaning of the Canteen after the serving of Afternoon Tea. (Including floors swept and mopped, dishes washed, dishwasher emptied.)
- 9. **DAILY: (HOME SIDE)** Assistance with the putting away of the Scorers' Table, the Scoreboard and Numbers and any gear from the Training Room to be put away NEATLY.
- 10. **DAILY: (HOME SIDE) AFTER EVERY DAY'S PLAY**, the Home Side is required to Clean up the Change Rooms, both **Home** and **Visitors** Rooms. Change Room Bins emptied and floors vacuumed. Bin Cage Key (3.24.200) from Bar. Vacuum is found in the Social Rooms.
- 11. **SEASONAL: (HOME SIDE) AT LEAST ONCE**, a player will be required to make/bring/purchase afternoon tea. (To include, but not be limited to: 3 loaves of bread for sandwiches, fillings to suit, fresh fruit platter, etc An allowance for up to \$30 for Afternoon tea has been made in the Daily Subs, and is reimbursable. Receipts required.)
- 12. **SEASONAL: (ALL)** AT THE END OF THE SEASON the SOCIAL ROOMS, CANTEEN and CHANGEROOMS have to be cleaned for handover to Council and the Football Club for the Winter Season. Your assistance during the "working bee" to clean the Rooms is urged.
